He is such a NICE horse to be around! We are also starting several horses in endurance training, one filly to be started under saddle this week and we are halter training Phoenix as well.”

In preparation for this important date, and in addition to the endurance competitions that Allegria de Los Cielos has been involved with throughout the year, the mare from Rancho de Los Cielos has participated to several events, including 3 parades, several rail shows, cowboy challenge events. Her trainer and rider, Alessandra Deerinck is also diversifying her experience by exposing her to different challenging situations, including riding on surface streets and at public parks, and training her with marathon college athletes. Last but not least, Alessandra has held lectures at the public library in Rancho Santa Fe, CA and Allegria has payed a visit to the library as well, appearing at the time when the lecture started, and then has patiently waited for it to end. Her next competition will be a fifty miles endurance ride in Descanso CA.

All of this is aimed to give the public the best image of what the Mangalarga Marchador horse can do for its rider. Basically being capable to do anything it is challenged with and succeed.”

Megan reports 13 foals registered for 2015 and 12 transfers.

There has been some problems in getting paperwork done in a timely manner. Megan and the USMMA Board are making some adjustments to provide better service in 2016.

- The steps for registration and for transfer will be documented and mailed to all USMMA members once a year. Oftentimes, paperwork is delayed because information is missing.
- Priority flat rate mail will be used for speed and for tracking purposes.
- Other ideas are also being discussed.

Get your registrations and transfers done early! There are late fee penalties. Remember that registration fees can be invoiced via paypal if that is more convenient than writing and mailing a check.
